CURE is dedicated to conquering childhood cancer through funding targeted research while supporting patients and their families.

CURE believes that childhood cancer can be cured in our lifetime.

CHILDHOOD CANCER STATISTICS

Every year, more than 17,000 children in the United States and more than 300,000 worldwide are diagnosed with cancer.

Incidence rates are increasing every year.

In the last 25 years, only six drugs have been developed and approved specifically for children.

Cancer is the leading cause of death by disease in children.

WHAT CAUSES CANCER IN CHILDREN?

Most childhood cancers are the result of DNA changes that happen early in the child's life, sometimes even before birth. Every time a cell divides into two new cells, it must copy its DNA.

This process isn't perfect, and errors sometimes occur, especially when the cells are growing quickly. Most of the time, these errors can be corrected by the cell. But when the genetic errors are so extensive that the cell cannot function normally, special genes order that the cell die for the good of the body as a whole.


When these corrections are not made, or when a diseased cell fails to self-destruct, cell growth and division can begin to break free of their constraints to become cancer cells. What causes cancer in children?

SUPPORTING LINNEA

Our Connection to CURE...The Johnson family with dancers Denver, Jack and Lucy have been longtime Powerhouse students. Their family has been dealing with a cancer diagnosis for their young cousin Linnea and CURE is part of their support team. Linnea spent the first 4 years of her life traveling around the US with her family in an RV. In January of 2022, they had to slam on the brakes after finding out Linnea had Leukemia. Linnea and her family rushed from Florida to Atlanta so she could be treated at Children's Healthcare of Atlanta while being surrounded by family and friends. In February of 2022, Linnea was officially diagnosed with a very rare type of leukemia called Hypodiploid ALL. She immediately began receiving chemotherapy at the Egleston campus of CHOA under the care of Dr. Sabnis. Since her diagnosis, she has undergone weekly infusions of chemotherapy, two 28 day long continuous immunotherapy infusions, 62 nights in the hospital, and numerous blood & platelet transfusions. Linnea is now 5 years old and 369 days into her chemotherapy journey with 492 days remaining. Linnea loves cooking, learning, ballet, and basketball, and playing with her little brother Liam and big sister Lorelei. She is quite the fashionista and enjoys dressing up and giving the family makeovers with lots of eye shadow! When she grows up, she wants to be a Child Life Specialist during the day and a night nurse until her bedtime at 9 pm. She also wants to be a fashion designer in her spare time!
