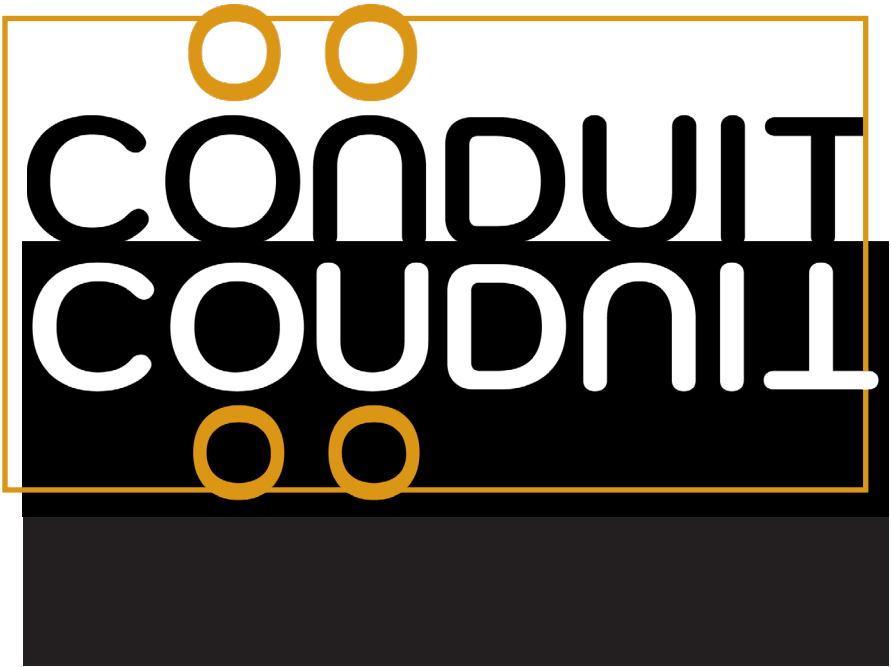

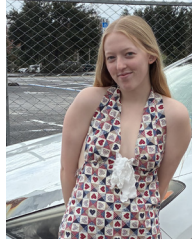
# Senior Cast

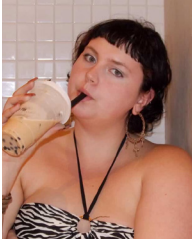


## **Caden Grinstead**

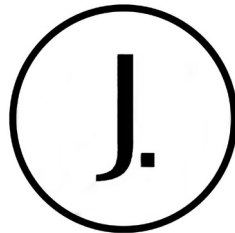

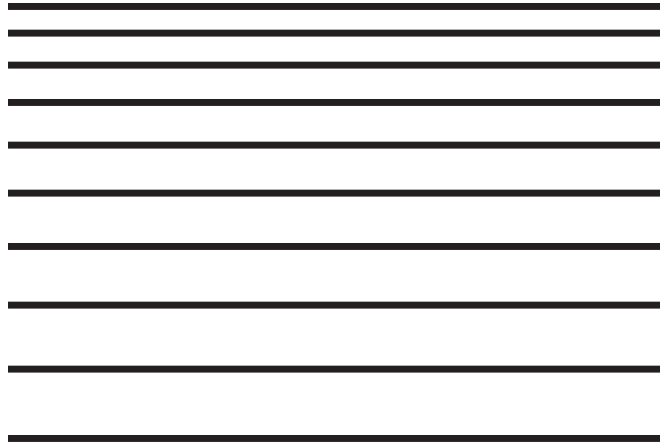

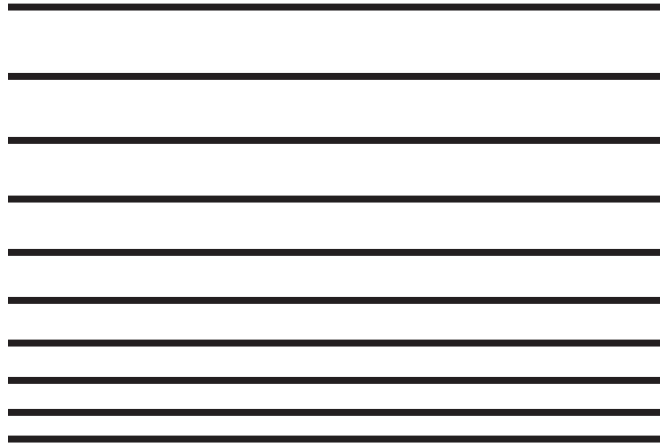
