DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Welcome!

I am so grateful you've chosen to join us for Archbishop Hoban High School's production of *Little Women* by Kate Hamill.

When I first stepped into this position, I had never read Louisa May Alcott's beloved novel, seen the musical, or encountered this particular adaptation. The students selected this play before knowing who would direct it or how it would be interpreted—an act of faith and curiosity that mirrors the spirit of discovery within the story itself. In many ways, it was the perfect choice for Hoban: a community navigating its own time of transition, growth, and renewal.

The world of *Little Women* is one of revelation, change, and industry. The March sisters challenge the expectations of their time, questioning the roles society has written for them—just as we question and redefine our own place in a rapidly changing world. As we explored the play together, three ideas became the foundation of our work: **Time, Dreams, and Personal Growth.**

Time moves relentlessly forward. The sisters cannot stop it; neither can we. Yet within its passage lies transformation. Our designs and performances aim to reflect that ever-turning clock—how moments slip by, how dreams evolve, and how we learn to grow through change rather than resist it.

Throughout rehearsals, we talked often about progress—how it shapes us individually, socially, and globally. We discovered that perspective is everything: the same event, seen through different eyes, can hold a thousand meanings. Like the March sisters, we come to realize that growth demands courage, and that pursuing our dreams often means stepping into the unknown.
