When last we left our adventurers... we had magic to do. Now, we do magic of another kind.

She Kills Monsters is a play that is just over 10 years old and has become a staple of the theatre community. This likely has to do with the fact that finding a person who does theatre or did theatre at a game of Dungeons and Dragons is a common occurrence. No doubt due to the fact, D&D shares many common activities with theatre: creating characters, making the best out of uncertain situations, and escaping to another world.

For the majority of the time that D&D has been a game, it's been viewed as nerdy due to the complexity of the system created and refined over the years, but only recently has it become more mainstream with its inclusion in Stanger Things, and the popularity of Critical Roll and Dimension20. It contains, Fantasy, Magic, and battles and while that isn't everyone's cup of tea more and more people are embracing this nerdy game for the fun and community that it creates.

In this story our "Average" protagonist, Agnes Evens. Is faced with the grieving process on top of navigating, Dating, Friendships, and Social activities. She is searching for a connection to her sister who was very opposite to herself. As we tend to as humans we stick to the familiar and that leads to us not always going beyond our comfort zone. I dare to say at some point in each of our lives we have felt "weird." I believe this show illustrates that this so-called weirdness is what makes us unique. Just because it isn't something we understand doesn't negate Its importance to another person. The list of things I don't understand is MUCH longer than the list of things I DO know. While I can't tell you the atomic weight of elements, or how to conjugate verbs in french, I have a bit of experience with both Theatre and Dungeons & Dragons, and regardless of if you do know about these things, I hope you can enjoy and appreciate this quest of growing up we present for you.

There is a simple truth, growing up is HARD. Everyone is awkward, and figuring out where we fit in the world is a trying experience. Even the most "average" people feel out of place. Navigating the social minefield of high school is treacherous on the best days and seemingly impossible on others. As we grow older it is easy to reflect on the past through the lens of nostalgia and forget sometimes the experience of major events without the benefit of hindsight. Understanding ourselves is one of the major questions we try to answer as we seek truth in the scope of the ever-changing societal norms. What each of us grew up with is defined in terms of generations and these benchmarks provide us with a collective understanding, but these things evolve over time. The thing of my mentors imparted the wisdom: "You never know what dragons someone is fighting."
